At the Chapter's next technical meeting, **Bob Archuleta, Private Investigator**, will advise members not to relax their vigilance against crime even though it is the season of yuletide trust and charity. Crime can happen anytime and, as Mr. Archuleta will point out, perpetrators have many underhanded ways to steal from unsuspecting businesses. How to guard against crime, particularly of the white collar variety, will be the topic Archuleta's talk. He will focus on both internal and

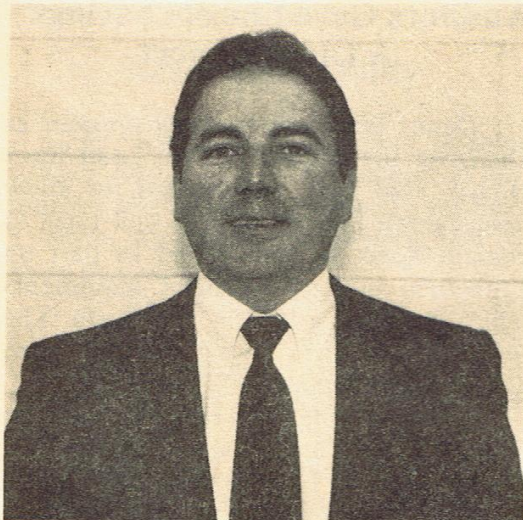
external theft, and describe some of his investigative techniques that help him snare white collar criminals. He will also review criminal and civil remedies that are available under the judicial system.

Mr. Archuleta owns and manages Archuleta & Associates, a local PI firm which has a staff of five. He began his career as a sleuth some eighteen years ago after graduating from Sacramento State with a BA degree in Criminal Justice. He was a sergeant with the Lodi Police Department for eleven years prior to opening his own business. Each new case, he says, is an educational experience as it requires learning a great deal about how his client's business operates.
